Learning Tips for Parents –MFL

Ensure your child has his/her book for their French or German lesson.

- Encourage your child to use their planner and check on their MFL homework deadlines. Look at your child's MFL book and ask them questions about the topics they are studying.
- Help your child learn the spellings of key words.

You can use the media to engage your child's interest in the world.

- When you watch the news you can discuss current issues that will be covered in their lessons.
- Encourage your child to read a newspaper. This is invaluable for them to understand current events; Global conflict, racism, etc.
- When you discuss your child's day at school you could use the internet to help them develop their understanding. Websites like the BBC and BBC Bitesize www.bbc.co.uk/education are useful to help discussions and your child to learn and develop how to express and justify his/her opinions.
