## Re: BTEC Sport Moderation Day

Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to inform you about the upcoming Moderation Day for BTEC Sport, which will be an exciting and important event for the students. This will take place on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July. The purpose of this day is to allow students to showcase their skills and abilities in either football (boys) or netball (girls), and to provide evidence for their BTEC Sport assessments.

On this day, students will need to come to school wearing their PE kits, as they will be actively participating in either football or netball matches and drills. Students may choose to bring any other necessary equipment such as football boots (non-metal studs) or netball trainers, shin guards, and any other personal sports gear you may require.

The moderation process is an essential part of their BTEC Sport qualification, as it allows student's teachers to assess their practical skills and knowledge and gain video evidence for external moderation. It is an opportunity for students to demonstrate their understanding of the sport's principles, techniques, and tactics. During the drills and matches, students will be observed and assessed by their teachers. This assessment will contribute to your final BTEC Sport grade. Therefore, it is crucial that students approach this day with enthusiasm, focus, and a determination to perform at your best.

We understand that football and netball may not be everyone's strongest sport, and student's may not want to use this for their assessed work. Students can collect their own video footage in a sport of their choice (or even further footage for football or netball if they wish) if they play for a club outside of school. They must include footage of:

- At least three different drills, covering three different skills. E.g passing, shooting, and dribbling.
- Filmed in a competitive situation (must be full sided and follow official rules).

If students would like to gain their own footage, this must be sent to their BTEC Sport teacher by **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September 2024**.
